# What to Expect

La Paz Gero-Psychiatric Center is a 148-bed locked Institute of Mental Disease (IMD) and Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) which serves adults and older adults with severe and persistent mental illnesses, who may also have medical complications or neuro-behavioral disorders. La Paz maintains a multidisciplinary team made up of psychiatrists, medical doctors, nurses, social workers, dietitians, and rehabilitative staff.

### Referrals

Residents are conserved by Los Angeles Public Guardians Office (LAPG) and referred to La Paz by the Los Angeles Department of Mental Health (LADMH)–County Wide Resource Management. Privately conserved residents not referred by LADMH are also accepted. La Paz maintains contractual agreements with several other counties from whom it accepts admissions as well.

### Treatment

Treatment at La Paz is based on the philosophy that all individuals have the potential to improve their level of functioning and make choices that impact their quality of life. The goal of La Paz is to reduce the symptoms of severe mental illness; provide safe, effective medical and psychiatric treatment to all residents; and allow individuals more choice and involvement in their treatment.

Residents are offered a variety of activities during their stay, including:

- Therapeutic groups
- Dance class
- Yoga
- Pet therapy
- Movie night
- Wii, karaoke, and table games
- Group outings, strolls
- Lending library
- Clothing boutique
- Religious services
- Special events: basketball games, baseball games, etc.
