About the Program:	Sacramento ARISE is a Full Service Partnership (FSP) program that will provide intensive outpatient services to individuals who meet the criteria stated above. ARISE's hallmark feature is a tiered pathway to recovery, with multidisciplinary staff organized into the following teams:

**Outreach, Engagement, & Specialty Services Team** provides peer support and specialty housing and employment services to all clients throughout their time in the program.

**High Intensity/Risk Team** stabilizes new clients, as well as any current clients in need of the highest level of wraparound support.

**Moderate Intensity/Risk Team** supports clients who have achieved initial stability and are ready to fully participate in groups and specialized vocational, educational, and employment services.

**Lower Intensity/Risk Team** supports clients who have established community tenure of one year or more, are meaningfully engaged in community activities, and are preparing for transition.



Sacramento ARISE is contracted through the County of Sacramento, Department of Health Services, Division of Behavioral Health Services and funded by the Mental Health Services Act.
