About the Program:	<p>At Carmen Lane, we provide comprehensive mental health and psychiatric treatment services in a safe, welcoming inpatient environment for adults with serious mental illness.</p> <p>Our 12-bed crisis residential treatment (CRT) includes a full team of nurses, psychiatrists, clinicians, peer specialists, and recovery specialists providing support 24 hours a day.</p> <p>Our services emphasize choice-making skills and harm-reduction techniques. Staff work with persons served within their cultural dynamic in building independence and self-responsibility in order to nurture recovery and successfully transition home or to less restrictive community settings.</p> <p>The Carmen Lane CRT program is under contract with Santa Barbara County Department of Behavioral Wellness.</p>
