Who We Are

At the Corrections Outpatient Recovery Enhancement (CORE) program in San Diego, our goal is to work closely with existing community resources to assist you with transitioning back into your community.

We believe that recovery can happen, and we will do whatever it takes to help you achieve your goals in life. CORE San Diego uses a multidisciplinary team approach, which includes personal service coordinators, peer advocates, clinicians, a prescriber, and a nurse.

Services are designed using the Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) model. CORE San Diego offers assistance to parolees with serious mental illness so they can live successfully in the community and achieve their personal recovery goals while avoiding a return to prison and unnecessary psychiatric hospitalization.

What to Expect

Our multidisciplinary intensive case management team is responsible for directly delivering and coordinating a variety of services and supports geared at reducing mental disability and harm, improving functioning, and promoting self-sufficiency and recovery.

Our culture is based on recovery. We believe in respect and non-judgment, and we celebrate individual uniqueness. We care about the interpersonal relationships we develop so we can foster a supportive program setting.

Our staff are passionate, resourceful, and motivated. They are partners in recovery, and will be with members throughout their journey.

Our goal is to be a team that helps members thrive. We want them to be the leader of their recovery journey, and to create the life they want for themselves.

Becoming a Member

All referrals to the programs are coordinated directly by the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR).

Admission Criteria

- Must have a serious mental illness
- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must currently be on parole living in San Diego County
- May have a history of a co-occurring substance abuse issue, a history of frequent psychiatric hospitalizations, or a history of being homeless
