At the TAO Central Full Service Partnership (FSP) program in Orange County, we are here to help you take positive steps toward the things that matter in your life.

We believe recovery starts from within, and that our job is to do whatever it takes to provide the support needed on your recovery journey. We have a full staff of peer specialists, a psychiatrist, a nurse, a master's prepared team lead, and personal service coordinators with experience in both drug and alcohol and mental health, who are all here to promote a program culture where resilience and hope can flourish, and losses can be recovered.

Our services are designed using Telecare's Recovery-Centered Clinical System (RCCS). This system incorporates evidence-based practices and emphasizes "power with" practices that aim to help individuals learn to make choices that lead to self-control, self-responsibility, and self-determination.

What to Expect

Your recovery plan starts with you. Upon arrival, a diverse clinical team will provide an individualized assessment and work with you every step of the way to support your goals in recovery.

Our culture is based on recovery. We believe in respect and non-judgment, and we celebrate individual uniqueness. We care about the interpersonal relationship we develop so we can foster a supportive program setting.

Our staff are passionate, resourceful, and motivated. They are your partners in recovery, and will be throughout your journey.

Our goal is to be a place that helps you thrive. We want you to be the leader of your recovery journey, and to create the life you want for yourself.
