At Telecare's Adult Telecare Los Angeles Services 7 (ATLAS 7) program, we are here to help you plan and build toward your long-term goals, not just short-term resolutions.

We believe that recovery starts from within. Our job is to do whatever it takes to support you in your recovery journey. We have a full staff of peer specialists and advocates, psychologists, personal service coordinators, masters-level therapists and social workers, nurses, and psychiatrists, who are all here to help you on your path.

Our program is based on the Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) model, where we connect you to the proper resources that can help you achieve your goals. We will work together with your family, friends, and the court system to help you take steps towards making recovery happen.

What to Expect

Your recovery will start with an individualized service plan where we will collaborate with you to determine your needs and goals moving forward. We will help you enhance your recovery process through empowering activities such as illness stabilization, learning critical community living and survival skills, finding suitable living arrangements, gaining opportunities to socialize, choosing, getting and keeping work, and crisis management, among other things.

Our culture is based on recovery. We believe in respect and non-judgment, and we celebrate individual uniqueness. We care about the interpersonal relationships we develop so we can foster a supportive program setting.

Our staff are passionate, resourceful, and motivated. They are your partners in recovery, and will be throughout your journey.

Our goal is to be a place that helps you thrive. We want you to be the leader of your recovery journey, and to create the life you want for yourself.
