Ages Served:	Adults who are homeless with a serious mental illness who may have a co-occurring substance use disorder, are not connected to outpatient services and are in acute care facilities, and will be discharged as a step-down in to the community.

About the Program:	The Tesoro program has been designed to help individuals who are being discharged from an acute care facility and not connected to outpatient services successfully transition back into their community.
	Program services are provided by a multidisciplinary team of counselors, case managers, peer specialist, vocational specialists, housing specialist, nurses, and a substance use specialist. Our prescriber provides direct service to members with no community-based physician. Evidence-based services include mental health services, case management services, crisis intervention, medication support services, dual diagnosis assessment and treatment, housing, and employment supports in community settings.
	Our goal is to work with individuals to address current barriers so they can transition back into and achieve their goals in their community.
	Tesoro is under contract with San Diego County Behavioral Health Services and is funded by the County of San Diego.
