Telecare Alameda County Youth CSU is a 10-bed program that has a multidisciplinary team of clinicians, psychiatric prescribers, nursing staff, and recovery specialists who are all here to help clients on their path.

Our services emphasize choice-making skills and harm-reduction techniques. We provide a safe, respectful environment where you can receive immediate, individualized assistance and a compassionate presence to stabilize symptoms, avoid the need for higher levels of care,

and receive appropriate referrals to community-based resources.

Services Provided:

- Access to psychiatric providers, nurses, social workers, and other clinical staff
- Psychiatric assessment
- Medication evaluation and service

- Development of crisis and recovery plans
- Linkage and referral to community treatment resources including medical services
