About the Program: At the Telecare OASIS program, you have the opportunity to connect with a

group of people who are here to be your support team.

We have a multidisciplinary team that includes a psychiatrist; a nurse; a program coordinator/licensed team lead; a clinician; a peer recovery coach; personal service coordinators with experience in drug, alcohol, and mental health treatment; and specialists in housing, education and employment, who

are all here to help you on your path.

The program receives referrals from the county. Referred individuals may be uninsured, Medi-Cal beneficiaries, or privately insured (AOT only).

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Referrals to the AOT program come directly from the county-operated AOT

engagement team.

NPLH referrals begin with county behavioral health FSP referral and require coordination with regional coordinated entry system (CES) per NPLH

regulations.

**Note:** OASIS is contracted through the County of Sacramento, Department of Health Services, and Division of Behavioral Health Services and funded by the Mental Health Services Act.
